You are invited to a Special Tour of the UBC Farm,

hosted by Dr. Sean Smukler, Assistant Professor, Applied Biology & Soil Science -Junior Chair, Agriculture and the Environment.

The Centre for Sustainable Food Systems at UBC Farm is a research centre and local-to-global food hub working towards a more sustainable, food-secure future.

The UBC Farm is the Centre for Sustainable Food System's main teaching and learning space. A 24-hectare integrated production farm, the UBC Farm is located on the traditional, ancestral, and unceded territory of the Musqueam people. Situated within a 90-year-old coastal hemlock forest, the UBC Farm comprises cultivated annual crop fields, perennial hedgerows and orchards, pasture, teaching gardens, and forest stands. All 24 hectares of the UBC Farm are organically managed, and UBC Farm produce is certified organic through NOOA. Over 200 varieties of fruits, vegetables, and herbs are cultivated with the farm also featuring honey beehives and egg-laying, open-pasture hens.
